The Cedar Rapids City Council will hold an electronic special City Council meeting on May 27, 2020 at 1:00 p.m. An electronic meeting is being held because a meeting in person is impossible or impractical due to concerns for the health and safety of Council members, staff and the public presented by COVID-19. An electronic meeting is allowed by Iowa Code Section 21.8 and Governor Reynolds’ Proclamation of Disaster Emergency, Section 69, dated April 2, 2020.

Any persons interested in commenting on the agenda items may do so in writing by emailing cityclerk@cedar-rapids.org.
